

## **4-H Dog Rally Resources**

### **Making Equipment at Home**

Signs - can be found on the Minnesota State 4-H Dog Project website, <http://www1.extension.umn.edu/youth/mn4-H/projects/animal-science/dog/> under Rally. These signs may be printed and should be placed in sheet protectors or laminated for durability.

Sign Holders - May be made in a variety of ways. Two options are:

1. 3-Ringbinder-Flipped open in order to stand up on the ground and hold the sign.
2. Cake Cardboards from a party store-Gently fold a 19 x 11 cardboard in half, reinforcing the fold with duct tape. Use Velcro with adhesive backing to attach signs and numbers.

Cones can be purchased from any hardware store, sporting goods store, or toy store.

Any dog food bowls may be used. They must be covered by some type of mesh to prevent dogs from getting to the food.
