	Description	Time	Supplies needed
Welcome/get acquainted activity	We will introduce ourselves to the group and explain why we are at this activity.	5-15 min.	We need a group of people and our animals in a carrier or pen.
Project hands on activity	We will talk about our animal breed, the name and their purpose.	15 min.	We need our animals and an emergency kit for accidents.
Recreation	We will ask the nursing home residents to talk about the animals that they have had in the past.	15-30 min.	Microphone
Snack	Our snack will include, egg salad sandwiches, hard boiled eggs, and beverages.	15-30 min.	
Optional business/decisions	This time will be an open discussion with the nursing home residents.		
Just in case Extra activity	We will read animal stories or sing songs if there is time.		We will need books and music.
